

Patient Responsibilities

As a patient of MarinHealth PET/CT Imaging, you have the following responsibilities:

- To be as accurate and complete as possible when providing medical history and treatment information.
- To disclose if you are a diabetic—your preparation instructions will be altered.
- To disclose if you are incontinent or a difficult IV start.
- To arrive with a photo ID.
- To prepare for your scan based on instructions given by the scheduler.
- To call us if you have any questions about your preparation.
- To inform scheduling 24 hours in advance for cancellations, to avoid \$250 cancellation fee.
- To be aware of the prostate cancer Axumin cancellation policy:

The cost of Axumin for the PET/CT exam is \$4,000. A patient who does not show up for the exam, arrives late, does not follow the exam preparation instructions, or cancels the appointment within less than 3 working days before their appointment date will be responsible for the \$4,000 cost of the isotope.

- To not bring any children or pregnant women with you due to risk of radiation exposure.
- To provide written medical advance directives, if applicable.
- To participate in decisions concerning your healthcare.
- To inform your doctor or nurse if you have questions or concerns regarding your imaging results.
- To abide by MarinHealth PET/CT Imaging policies.
- To be considerate of MarinHealth PET/CT's employees and other patients.
- To examine your bill and ask questions.
- To be responsible for providing appropriate information for insurance claims and acknowledging payment responsibility if insurance does not cover the full cost of services.
