

Zoom Instructions for Patient Video Visits

To make an appointment:

- You will need a computer, tablet, or smartphone with speaker or headphones.
 You will have the opportunity to check your audio and video prior to joining a meeting.
- Your visit invitation email will include a link to "Join a Zoom Meeting" as well as the Meeting ID and password.

A day before the video visit:

- If you don't already have Zoom on your computer, please download and install the application prior to the visit. Go to https://zoom.us/download and from the **Download** Center, click on the **Download** button under "**Zoom** Client for Meetings". This application will automatically **download** when you start your first **Zoom** Meeting
- 2) Or, join a test meeting at: https://zoom.us/test

To join the videoconference:

- 1. Five (5) minutes prior to the start time of your visit, click on the link in your invitation to **join zoom meeting**. You may be instructed to download the Zoom application.
- You may also join a video visit without clicking on the invitation link by going to https://zoom.us/join on any browser and entering the Meeting ID provided by your provider's office.
- 3. You will have an opportunity to retest your audio at this point by clicking on the ^ caret symbol next to microphone picture on the control panel. Now, click on "Test Speakers & Microphone".

By accepting this invitation you consent to hold this visit by video. A video visit is billed in the same way as an in-person clinic visit. The terms of your deductible and copay still apply.
